Broncos complete season 26-27 overall, 18-22 in CCAA

Broncos complete season: Cal Poly Pomona completed the 2010 season with a 26-27 overall record and 18-22 in the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) with a weekend trip to Sonoma State. The Broncos took 3 of 4 games from the Seawolves and finished sixth in the CCAA and eight games back of 4th-place and final CCAA Tourney rep Chico State. The 18 conference victories are the most since CPP went 25-14 and won the CCAA South in 2005.

Rebuilding year in 2010?: The Broncos return just two defensive starters – **CF Travis Tajeron** and **C/1B Jenzen Torres** – and **DH Tyson Edwards** for the 2011 season. The Broncos look to have a solid rotation as starting RHP **Kevin Bosson** is expected to return after missing much of 2009 with an arm injury. RHP **Geoff Broussard** will return for his third season as a starter after leading CPP in wins with seven this past season. In all, CPP loses 12 seniors, but expects to have a total of 17 letterwinners back.

All-CCAA performers: **Torres** and **Tajeron** were the only Broncos to earn All-CCAA status in the announcement made this week. **Torres** earned first-team status as a utility player and becomes CPP's first first-teamer since **C Anthony Esquer** in 2006. **Torres**, a Valencia native, hit .313 with 12 home runs and a team-leading 54 RBI -- the most for a Bronco in nine years. He split duty with 26 starts at first base and 24 starts behind the plate. **Torres** was a second-team selection a year ago and is the only

sophomore to make the first team.

Tajeron completed his first season with a school-record 16 home runs that led the CCAA. He hit .345 with 48 RBI and totaled a team-high 31 extra-base hits.

All-Region honors: Torres earned NCBWA All-West Region honors and was named to the ABCA/Rawlings All-West Region honors. He was named as a utility player on both teams.

Tajeron was named second-team ABCA/Rawlings as an outfielder.

Two records set: The 16 HRs by Travis Tajeron eclipsed the school record of 14 set by Ryan Vorell in 2001. Senior **Joshua Krist** became the school's single-season saves leader with seven to surpass Sean Hunter's mark of six established in 2007.

Power the name of the game: The Broncos showed power this season at the plate. CPP out-homered its opponents 48-34 and had more RBI (303-289) for the season.

No. 1 for a reason: CPP opened the season 17-11, but ran into buzz saw that is UC San Diego in late March that put a damper on the Broncos' season. A 5-3 loss to Grand Canyon on March 21 was the beginning of a season-worst 6-game losing streak as the Tritons earned a 4-game sweep over the Broncos. CPP then lost a series opener to Cal State L.A. 9-4 on April 1, before stopping the streak one day later with a win at CSULA.

The Broncos hovered around the .500 level and they made a run late when they won four straight. The season-ending loss to Sonoma State finished CPP's season at 26-27 overall.

So Close ...Senior RHP **Jarett Attard** pitched the game of his Broncos career on Senior Day (April 25) when he took a perfect game into the eighth inning against Cal State Stanislaus.

The Poway native issued a walk to the first batter of the eighth, but the no-hitter was still intact. He got within four outs of a no-hitter until a hard-hit liner up the middle by a pinch-hitter broke

up the no-hitter.

Attard went on to throw eight innings and gave up two hits with three strikeouts and a walk.
